The Majik Vineyard is a mere 1 acre of vines high up on a ridge in the Sebastopol Hills, due west of downtown Sebastopol. Planted in 2000 to a spicy selection of clone 7, this tiny planting has been a monumental vineyard in terms of relearning the limits of ripeness in Syrah grown in west county. Always delicate with savory olive-scented meaty flavors, but always gorgeous in its purity of fruit and clarity of site and variety. A perennial favorite.

Tasting Note:

Meaty, black olive aromas and dense blackberry liqueur fill the glass. Dark and concentrated fruit and Whole-Cluster goodness work in tandem to create our favorite kind of west county Syrah, vibrant, alive, and authentic. Light on its feet and medium bodied at best, but completely delicious. Mis-understood by many, this is one for the purists, those that can tell the difference between real and fake, that sweetness and layers of new oak are not complexity and that good is better than big.
